



Learn how to increase your accuracy and efficiency in forest inventory, tree measurement, and tree positioning. 8:00 Participants will go head-to-head in a ocular estimation competition for borderline trees, diameters, heights, and upper stem diameters and then use Haglof's state-of-the-art calipers, lasers, DMEs, and clinometers to do it better and 11:45 faster. 
